



GIFT AID DECLARATION

The gift aid scheme allows charities such as NSCCP - The Counselling Partnership to reclaim tax on donations paid to us by donors who pay income or capital gains tax. If you sign up to the scheme the charity can claim 28% of the subscription amount from the government.

You can benefit too: If you pay the higher rate of tax you can claim tax relief on the difference between the higher and basic rates of tax.

5. Declarations will be held separately from client records but we may be required to provide your Declaration if the Charity is being audited by HMRC.
